Objectives:

- To build and spread knowledge regarding innovation's transformative relevance in the Administrative Sciences under the topic: "Innovation in the Digital Era: Strategic Agility and Transformation".
- To foster a favorable environment for the meeting of researchers, academics, students
 and professionals in the Administrative Sciences and related disciplines in order to
 analyze and discuss the new trends of the Digital Era and organizational innovations.
- To create a space for the submission of research projects from undergraduate and postgraduate students, in order to encourage the interest on science, technology and research, generating knowledge that promotes strategic innovation in public and private organizations, which in turn will help face disruptive environments in a competitive manner.
- To motivate the publication of the best submitted research projects in the journal Teoría y Praxis de ACACIA and other high-quality national and international indexed academic journals.

Context for the Congress

Nowadays, top management, counselors, executives and businessmen face one of the biggest challenges in their organizations due to the pandemic generated by COVID-19. Amongst these new challenges we find the new working at a distance practices or *home office*, different business hybrid models, the change of the role of human capital in business, as well as new organizational responsibilities towards society in the economic and social post-pandemic recovery. The post-COVID 19 world needs organizations which can swiftly adapt through innovation and continuous digital transformation to be able to grow and consolidate in the market. Interaction with different *stakeholders*, including the government and academia will be key during this transformational process, not only for Mexico but for the international community at large.

Congress format:

The Congress will be hybrid, which means that the speakers will get to decide how best to present in a synchronic way. Those speakers which can attend on-campus will be welcome at Universidad de Monterrey, and those that cannot travel to the main campus will be able to present on-line. In-person attendance at Monterrey will be conditioned to the authorizations and recommendations of the local health and government authorities



I. Guidelines for speakers' participation:

The maximum number of speakers per presentation is three.


- 1. The maximum number of papers an author may present is two (2)
- 2. Proposals may be submitted in Spanish, English or French.
- 3. The paper must be unpublished, an outcome of theoretical or empirical research, and submitted with partial or final conclusions. In all cases, research must be original, relevant and developed with strict scientific and methodological rigor.
- 4. The minimum paper length is 15 pages and maximum length is 25, including summary, graphs, tables, references and all annexes. It must be sent in Word format (doc, docx).
- 5. Use Arial 12 font, 1.5 cm spacing an 2.5 cm margins (top, bottom, left and right), with centered numbering at the bottom of the page. The paper's title is the main heading.
- 6. All proposals that do not fulfill the previous format requirements will not be considered for the Congress.
- 7. Proposal must be sent in two files:
 - a. **File 1**. Full paper: title, summary of maximum 250 words, no more than three keywords, introduction that includes objective and research problem, theoretical framework, analysis of results, conclusions and references in APA 6 format. In this file the authors name will not be included.
 - b. **File 2**. Cover Page: Congress information, paper's title, author(s) information ordered by contribution, phone number and email of the main author and institutional affiliation. Note: Please write down the chapter in which you are participating.
 - c. When choosing your chapter, you should take into account the working guidelines for the keywords.
- 8. No proposals will be accepted that are submitted at the same time for the V Encuentro de Jóvenes Investigadores and/or the XII Coloquio de Posgrado.
- 9. Author(s) who transfer their papers' rights for publication (Copyright Transfer Agreement) should include a copy of their official identification (INE, DNI or passport).
- 10. All proposals will be submitted to double blind peer-review.
- 11. The paper should be submitted for only one Congress chapter, otherwise it will be automatically rejected

- 13. All proposals must be uploaded through the congress website https://www.udem.edu.mx/es/institucional/congreso-acacia-2022. The author will be able to follow his submission through the same website, or by email notifications.
- 14. The best proposals for each chapter will receive special recognition and the right to be published in the *Revista Ciencias Administrativas, Teoría y Praxis* or any other journals in collaboration with ACACIA.
- 15. The Academy for Administrative Sciences will grant the award "Raúl Conde" to the best Congress proposal with a special recognition for quality, contribution and scientific and methodological rigor.
- 16. Those proposals with methodological and scientific rigor, as dictaminated through double-blind peer-review, and selected for each chapter will be published in an ACACIA electronic journal with ISSN.
- 17. Only those proposals that meet the format requirements and payment deadlines will be considered for presentation and publication.



- 18. Papers for the different chapters can only be submitted by the author or coauthors, no submissions will be accepted by other third parties.
- 19. Only those proposals meeting the aforementioned terms and conditions will be accepted. Any other circumstances which might arise will be evaluated by ACACIA's Coordinación Académica del Congreso and Vicepresidencia de Capítulos.

II. Presentation of books and journals


Amongst the Congress activities, there will be room for the presentation of printed or electronic books and journals relevants for administrative sciences within the following considerations:

- The presentation must be registered and submitted to the Congress website https://www.udem.edu.mx/es/institucional/congreso-acacia-2022 under the Presentación de libros y/o Revistas section. You must include: front page, authors, edition date, oficial book or journal index in pdf file, writing down the name and general information of the presenter.
- Printed and online books and journals from renowned publishers will be accepted. For books, publishing houses must be registered in CANIEM (Cámara Nacional de la Industria Editorial Mexicana) or its international equivalents, and for journals they must be indexed in Latindex, Redalyc, Scopus and/or SSCI.
- 3. Editing date for the book must be 2020 onwards.
 - 4. Presentation will be in a special session, with an allowed time of 10 minutes per work.
 - 5. It is recommended donating to ACACIA and the Universidad de Monterrey a sample of the submitted work.
 - 6. Registration for publications will be from April 1st to 22nd, 2022.
 - 7. Acceptance of presentations will be confirmed by April 29th, 2022 at the latest.
 - 8. The Congress will not allow the presentation of publications which have not been registered.
 - 9. Any scheduling or circumstances not considered in this Call is competence of the Coordinación Académica del Congreso.


