Objectives:

- To build and spread knowledge regarding innovation's transformative relevance in the Administrative Sciences under the topic: "Innovation in the Digital Era: Strategic Agility and Transformation".
- To foster a favorable environment for the meeting of researchers, academics, students and professionals in the Administrative Sciences and related disciplines in order to analyze and discuss the new trends of the Digital Era and organizational innovations.
- To create a space for the submission of research projects from undergraduate and postgraduate students, in order to encourage the interest on science, technology and research, generating knowledge that promotes strategic innovation in public and private organizations, which in turn will help face disruptive environments in a competitive manner.

Context for the Congress

Nowadays, top management, counselors, executives and businessmen face one of the biggest challenges in their organizations due to the pandemic generated by COVID-19. Amongst these new challenges we find the new working at a distance practices or *home office*, different business hybrid models, the change of the role of human capital in business, as well as new organizational responsibilities towards society in the economic and social post-pandemic recovery. The post-COVID 19 world needs organizations which can swiftly adapt through innovation and continuous digital transformation to be able to grow and consolidate in the market. Interaction with different *stakeholders*, including the government and academia will be key during this transformational process, not only for Mexico but for the international community at large.

ACACIA welcomes research proposals for its nineteen chapters which offer new approaches for analyzing public and private organizations' adaptation to the new competitive environment.

Meeting of Junior Researchers Meeting format:

The meeting will be hybrid, which means that the speakers will get to decide how best to present in a synchronic way. Those speakers which can attend on-campus will be welcome at Universidad de Monterrey, and those that cannot travel to the main campus will be able to present on-line. In-person attendance at Monterrey will be conditioned to the authorizations and recommendations of the local health and government authorities

I. Guidelines for speakers' participation:

The maximum number of speakers per presentation is three.

- 1. The maximum number of authors in a paper is four (4).
- 2. Proposals may be submitted in Spanish, English or French.
- 3. The paper must be unpublished, an outcome of theoretical or empirical research, and submitted with partial or final conclusions. In all cases, research must be original, relevant and developed with strict scientific and methodological rigor.

- 4. The minimum paper length is 10 pages and maximum length is 20, including summary, graphs, tables, references and all annexes. It must be sent in Word format (doc, docx).
- 5. Use Arial 12 font, 1.5 cm spacing an 2.5 cm margins (top, bottom, left and right), with centered numbering at the bottom of the page. The paper's title is the main heading.
- 6. All proposals that do not fulfill the previous format requirements will not be considered for the Meeting.
- 7. Proposal must be sent in two files:
 - a. **File 1**. Full paper: title, summary of maximum 250 words, no more than three keywords, introduction that includes objective and research problem, theoretical framework, analysis of results, conclusions and references in APA 6 format. In this file the authors name will not be included.
 - b. **File 2**. Cover Page: Consortium information, paper's title, author(s) information ordered by contribution, phone number and email of the main author and institutional affiliation. Note: Please write down the chapter in which you are participating.
 - c. When choosing your chapter, you should take into account the working guidelines for the keywords.
- 8. All proposals will be submitted to double blind peer-review.
- 9. The paper should be submitted for only one Junior Researchers Meeting chapter, otherwise it will be automatically rejected

- 10. All proposals must be uploaded through the congress website <u>https://www.udem.edu.mx/es/institucional/congreso-acacia-2022</u>. The author will be able to follow his submission through the same website, or by email notifications.
- 11. Only those proposals that meet the format requirements and payment deadlines will be considered for presentation.
- 12. Papers for the different chapters can only be submitted by the author, no submissions will be accepted by other third parties.
- 13. Only those proposals meeting the aforementioned terms and conditions will be accepted. Any other circumstances which might arise will be evaluated by ACACIA's Junior Researchers Meeting committee.




