Monterrey is the capital and largest city of the northeastern state of Nuevo León, Mexico.

Located at the foothills of the Sierra Madre Oriental, the city is anchor to the Monterrey metropolitan area, the second most productive in Mexico and the second-largest metropolitan area in Mexico with an estimated population of 5,341,171 people as of 2020.

Monterrey is one of the most livable cities in Mexico, and is the base of many significant international corporations.

Weather

The average temperature in Monterrey in November for a typical day ranges from a high of $76^{\circ}F$ ($25^{\circ}C$) and a low of $52^{\circ}F$ ($11^{\circ}C$). Some would describe it as mildly cool with a gentle breeze.

Some Tourist Attractions

* Santa Lucía Riverwalk, an artificial river built between 1996 and 2007. It currently joins the Macroplaza with the Fundidora Park.

* The Macroplaza, one of the world's largest squares, is the cultural and administrative heart of the city featuring remarkable monuments, green areas and buildings.

* Faro del Comercio (Lighthouse of Commerce), another trademark of the city. This monuments beams a green laser around the city at night.

* Barrio Antiguo (lit. Old neighborhood or old town) is the historical urban center of the city of Monterrey. There are preserved the old houses from the XVII, XVIII and XIX centuries. Nowadays bars, cafes, art galleries and restaurants can be found there.

* The Museum of Modern Art is a post-modern Mexican architecture designed by Ricardo Legorreta with the objective of creating different ambiances for artists and visitors from all around the world.
