Integrity: A Transformative Commitment

Dear researcher, educator, administrator, or student, the 13th Academic Integrity Conference, which will be held on site and online on September 24, 25 and 25, is an excellent opportunity to strengthen the culture of academic integrity, of national and international educational institutions.

The organizing committee, Universidad de Monterrey in collaboration with Universidad Panamericana, Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile, Tecnológico de Monterrey, Universidad Tecmilenio, Universidad del Itsmo in Guatemala, CETYS Universidad, Universidad Autónoma de Nuevo León, and Universidad de las Americas Puebla; with the endorsement of the International Center for Academic Integrity (ICAI), the European Network for Academic Integrity (ENAI) and the Federation of Mexican Private Higher Education Institutions (FIMPES) Invites you to share your proposals in Spanish or English, that present original findings –completed or in progress- on any of the following topics related to academic integrity:

- Educational innovation: resources, experiences, and best practices to promote Academic Integrity.
- Regulations to strengthen Academic Integrity (policies and governance).
- Culture of Academic Integrity.
- Artificial intelligence, the digital world, and their implications for Academic Integrity.
- From Academic Integrity to professional ethics.

The evaluation committee, compose of the representatives from the collaborating universities, will consider the following criteria:

- 1. **Relevance of the theme:** The proposal's alignment with the conference topics and its significance in the current academic context.
- 2. **Methodological rigor:** A clear, and meaningful results that are relevant to the field of academic integrity.
- 3. **Significance of results:** The proposal presents meaningful and relevant findings that contribute to the field of academic integrity.
- 4. **Applicability of the conclusions:** the conclusions or findings are valuable to other institutions and can be applied or replicated.

Formats:

Presentation: 25 minutes.

Poster oral presentation: 10 minutes

Workshop or roundtable session: 25 minutes.

Deadline for proposal submissions: August 8, 2025.

Notification of acceptance: August 25, 2025.

The 13th Academic Integrity Conference will take place in both on site and online formats on September 24, 25 and 26, 2025, and represents an excellent opportunity to share resources, tools, and best practices to strengthen the culture of Academic Integrity among students, faculty, and administrators from national and international educational institutions.
