14.º Academic Integrity Conference: Building the Future through Integrity

Dear researcher, faculty member, administrator, and student:

The organizing committee of the 14th Academic Integrity Conference, composed of the Universidad de Monterrey, in collaboration with Universidad Panamericana, Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile, Tecnológico de Monterrey, Universidad Tecmilenio, Universidad del Istmo (Guatemala), CETYS Universidad, Universidad Autónoma de Nuevo León, and Universidad de las Américas Puebla; with the endorsement of the International Center for Academic Integrity (ICAI), the European Network for Academic Integrity (ENAI), and the Federation of Mexican Private Higher Education Institutions (FIMPES), invites you to share your proposals for presentations reporting original results, whether completed or in progress, in either English or Spanish, in any of the following academic integrity topics:

1. Educational innovation: resources, experiences, and best practices in support of academic integrity
2. Regulations to strengthen academic integrity (policies and governance)
3. Culture of academic integrity
4. Artificial intelligence, the digital world, and their implications for academic integrity
5. From academic integrity to professional ethics

Evaluation Criteria

- Thematic relevance: Addressing the topics mentioned above, with current information and data.
- Methodological rigor: Systematic, clear, and coherent presentation of the arguments.
- Value of results: Presentation of results relevant to academic integrity development and consolidation.
- Applicability of conclusions: Useful for guiding teaching practices within the different educational levels.

Formats

- Presentation (25 minutes): Presentation of projects, experiences, proposals or recent conclusions.
- Research Report (20 minutes): Communication of study advancement, findings and/or results.
- Workshop or Working Session (25 minutes): Collaborative/practical session to facilitate knowledge co-construction.
- Poster (10 minutes): Scientific poster presentation that summarize theories, methods, procedures, advances, results or recommendations with discussion.

Important Dates

Submission deadline: August 17, 2026

Notification of acceptance: August 31, 2026

The 14th Academic Integrity Conference will be held in both in-person and online formats on September 23–25, 2026. It will be an excellent opportunity to share resources and strengthen academic integrity between national and international communities.

Presenters are encouraged to ensure in-person participation.

Submission Requirements by Format

- Presentation (slides) for projection (.ppt, .pdf) including the following elements: - Title slide with the presentation title, authors, and institutional affiliation - Introduction - Body of the topic - Conclusions - References in APA format - The file name must be “P-” followed by the first name and last name of the first author.	- Abstract: A brief text that summarizes a research study. It includes the title, authors, and institutional affiliation; introduction, thesis statement, theoretical framework, objectives, methodology, results, and conclusions. - The oral presentation will be supported by slides (.ppt, .pdf) following the APA structure: Title slide, introduction, body, conclusion, and references. - The file name must be “I-” followed by the first name and last name of the first author. If selected, the final version of the report must be submitted no later than the day of the presentation for review and possible publication, in APA format.	- Description of the activity to be carried out. - Logistics required for the implementation of the workshop. - Presentation (slides) for projection (.ppt, .pdf): - Title slide with the presentation title, authors, and institutional affiliation - Include references in APA format. - The file name must be “T-” followed by the first name and last name of the first author.	- Poster image, 1755 pixels wide × 1240 pixels high (high-resolution .jpg or .png format). - Deliver a 10-minute oral presentation. - Include references in APA format. - The file name must be “PS-” followed by the first name and last name of the first author. If selected, the poster must measure 60 × 90 cm (or vice versa) for printing.
